## Ideas for joint projects and UK-German partner work

**Summary:** Pupils make a model of the *bears'* market stall  
**Topics:** Food, the *UK-German bears*

Activity	Description
Send by post	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils exchange snacks and treats by post (e.g. typical British / German sweets.)</li> </ul>
Send online	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils see who can make the most attractive bears' market stall and exchange photographs of the finished items.</li> </ul>
Picture dictionary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils take digital photos of ten 'market stall' items and send them to their partners, with vocabulary (e.g. 'potato', 'carrot' etc.) - could be done as a Word document, Power Point presentation etc.</li> </ul>
Make & do	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils create an illustrated shopping list in German with realistic prices in Euros, then decide what they would buy for 10 Euros.</li> <li>Pupils create and exchange recipes for regional / seasonal dishes.</li> </ul>
Audio / Video	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils go to a local market and film themselves / the stall owners introducing items from a market stall.</li> <li>Pupils act and film a market stall role play.</li> </ul>
Top five things	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils compare lists of their favourite foods, vegetables, snacks etc.</li> </ul>
Useful phrases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils create a list of five useful 'market' phrases for their partners - e.g. "I would like a ...", "How much does the ... cost?" etc.</li> </ul>
Quiz	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils create a multiple choice 'market' quiz to challenge their partners.</li> </ul>
